


Things To Do

About The Area



The Royal Burgh of Rosehearty is situated 4 miles west of Fraserburgh, with a population of approx 1250.

Rosehearty is one of the oldest sea ports in Scotland dating back to the 14th Century. During the nineteenth centuries herring boom, there were 12 curing houses and its fishing fleet supported 600 people.

It is also 4 miles from New Aberdour, 18 miles from Macduff and 19 miles from Banff and 48 miles from Aberdeen.

Following the coast road into Pittulie and Sandhaven, the seals lie sunbathing every day on the rocks just past Sandhaven Harbour.

Plenty to see and do: The Moray Firth has beautiful Coastal Villages, incl. Pennan and Crovie which are very picturesque and only a few miles away. Pennan was the location for the Film 'Local Hero' with it's famous Telephone Box.

It is also within travelling distance to the Famous Whisky Trail.

Rosehearty is surrounded by Wild life & Birds. Lovely just to sit on the seats looking out to sea, very relaxing and most enjoyable. Or take a stroll along the "West Rocks" and you can regularly see the minke whales feeding out at sea, and very occasionally you might catch sight of a pod of dolphins. So don't forget your Binoculars!
